The British Society for Oral and Dental Research (BSODR) was formed to advance research and increase knowledge for the improvement of oral health in the United Kingdom.



### Our objectives

- To encourage junior workers to become involved in oral and dental research
- To facilitate the dissemination and application of research findings relating to oral health and the interactions between oral and systemic health

### Our mission

- To advance research and increase knowledge for the Improvement of oral health in the United Kingdom
- To support and represent the oral health research community in the UK
- To encourage young workers, dentally or scientifically qualified, to become involved in oral and dental research
- To facilitate the dissemination and application of research findings relating to oral health and the interactions between oral and systemic health
- To foster the development of international research collaboration through the International Association for Dental Research (IADR) and its federations



The Society is a Division of the International Association for Dental Research (IADR) and also a member of a federation of European research societies - Pan European Region (PER). The members of the PER are the IADR divisions from Great Britain, Continental Europe, Ireland, Israel and Scandinavia (NOF).

Under various names, the BSODR has been meeting since 1953, but even before that, groups of British researchers had been meeting in London since 1931. The Society therefore has a long and rich heritage.

Now, the BSODR meets on an annual basis. Meetings alternate between the UK and a joint meeting with our PER partners.

Recent meetings have been held in Durham (2007), PER-London (2008), Glasgow (2009), PER-Barcelona (2010), Sheffield (2011), PER-Helsinki (2012), Bath (2013), PER-Dubrovnik (2014), Cardiff (2015), PER-Jerusalem (2016), Plymouth (2017), IADR-London (2018), Leeds (2019) and Birmingham (2021). Future meetings will include PER-Marseille (2022), London-GMUL (2023) and Newcastle (2024).

## 5c. Honorary Treasurer report (Anousheh Alavi)

Independent Examination of accounts to 31 December 2020

Income from membership subscriptions, awards, donations and investments

- Year to 31 December 2020:
  - Income decreased by £17,776 (58.1%) principally due to no forthcoming income from meetings in the year
  - Income from charitable activities also decreased by £1,639 (14.62%) as a result of a decrease in membership numbers from 506 to 412
  - Charitable expenditure decreased by £5,962 (16.2%): fall in governance costs: Society is now subject to an independent examination, not an audit, together with reduced meetings and research presentations.



## 5c. Honorary Treasurer report (Anousheh Alavi)

Independent Examination of accounts to 31 December 2020

- Year to 31 December 2020:
  - The investments held by the Society at 31 December 2020 increased in market value by £25,029 (6.7%) compared to the previous year end.
  - Income from current investments fell to £7,366 from £8,201 in the previous year.



## 5c. Honorary Treasurer report (Anousheh Alavi)

Independent Examination of accounts to 31 December 2020

- **Reserves policy** The BSODR Management Committee have a policy of maintaining sufficient level of reserves to enable the charity to fulfil its objectives. Restricted reserves of £5,457 are for BSODR prizes, bursaries and sponsorships where the amounts are funded by a third party.
- Designated reserves brought forward of £2,000 are to be used towards Early Career Research Awards.
